"IN CLASS" LEARNING

Some learning will take place through personal study, some lectures, group activities, and other class work. Some learning will also take place through observation. Classes will be conducted primarily in the morning.

HANDS ON MINISTRY

The primary avenue for learning will take place in real world situations. Each student will work towards applying what they learn in class by doing ministry. Partnering with Jesus in working for souls is key. Imagine failing, learning, trying again, and being successful, all in a supportive environment!

These opportunities will take place in the afternoon/evenings during the week, as well as the student making a commitment to participate and conduct outreach three Sabbaths a month with an assigned church.
